We conduct a review of credentials on a regular basis, following standards that are established by state regulations and accrediting organizations.

Once credentialing verification's completed, behavioral health providers must meet the approved inclusion into our network by Aetna's Credentialing peer committee.

We also require that our in-network facilities be either accredited by a national or state organization or they pass an on-site review that's conducted by a licensed clinician.
